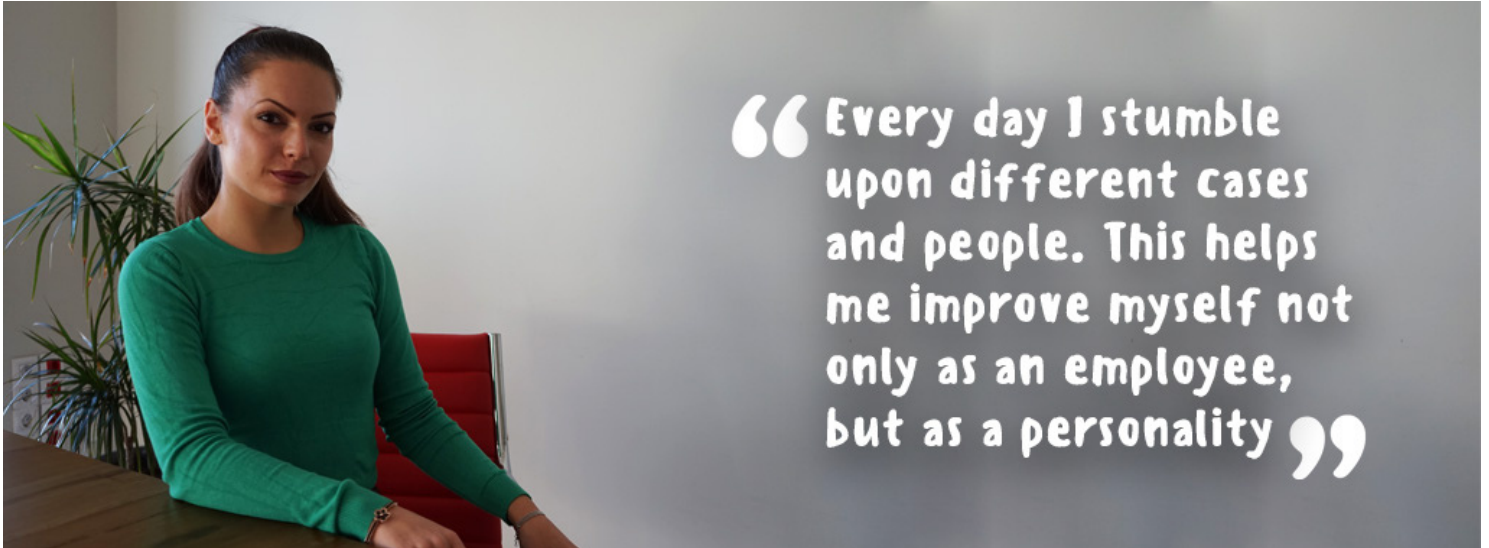


**Hristo Angelov**
